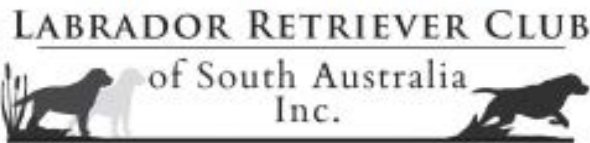

Baby Puppy	1	For dogs aged three and under six months. (Not eligible for Challenge)
Minor Puppy	2	For dogs aged six and under nine months.
Puppy	3	For dogs aged six and under twelve months.
Junior	4	For dogs aged nine and under eighteen months.
Intermediate	5	For dogs aged eighteen and under thirty-six months
Limit	8	For dogs over twelve months of age which are not Champions, or have not gained sufficient points to qualify as a Champion, up to and including the day before the date of entry close.
Australian Bred	10	For dogs aged six months or over bred in Australia
Open	11	For dogs aged six months or over and of a breed or variety recognized by Dogs Australia.
Veteran	12	7 years and over
Open Neuter	18	For neuter dogs aged six months or over

9. 1.2.9 Where Member Body regulations allow for Property and Special Classes at Specialty Shows, **Neuter dogs and bitches shall be eligible to enter.**
10. 1.2.10 Colour classes are to count as one class for challenge provided that the colours are permitted in the authorised breed standard.

1.3 Special Classes

1. 1.3.1 Special classes may be offered at approved conformation shows. These classes are for exhibition only and are not eligible for challenge points.
2. **1.3.2 Brace:** For two dogs each six months of age and over, of the same breed, each of which has competed in at least one other breed class or neuter class at the sanctioned show and each of which is registered in the same ownership and are handled in the judging ring by one person.
3. **1.3.4 Breeders Team:** Minimum of four dogs six months of age and over of the same breed, bred under one prefix each of which has competed in at least one other breed class or neuter class at the same approved show.
4. **1.3.5 Progeny:**
 1. **Sire and progeny** - entry to consist of the sire and a minimum of three of his progeny from at least two different dams.
 2. **Dam and progeny** – entry to consist of the dam and a minimum of three of her progeny sired by at least two different sires from two different litters.

JUDGES' PROFILES



Sven Slettedal (NOR) - Fieldvalley Labradors

Thank you to the committee for the invitation to judge the Australian 13th National Labrador Retriever Championship Show.

I got my first Labrador when I was 12 years old (1967). She was by Ch. Sandylands Rough Tweed (litter brother to S. Tan) x a pet dog. I go to dog show with her, but with little success.

I was lucky to meet enthusiastic people of the breed at some shows. First of all, Mr. and Mrs. Havaker from Sweden (Mallards Labradors) and Mrs. Eva Mjelde

(Surprisings Labradors) who supported me with advice and help.

In 1982 I married my wife, and in 1985 we contacted Les and Joyce Brabbans, Cambremer Labradors, and asked them for a puppy. Ch. Cambremer Bianca came to us in 1985 (Cambremer Montclear x Ch. Charway Blackthorn of Follytower) Visiting Les and Joyce, they took me to Audrey and Allan Chapman, Croftspa kennel. I bought Croftspa Chinatea a year later from them. She was half-sister to Ch. Croftspa Hazelnut of Foxrush. At that time, the breed record holder.

Both bitches became Norwegian Champions and I breed from them. I still breed from these lines today and I am now on my 11th generation. I have not bought a bitch since C. Chinatea in 1986. I have breed 29 champions, most of them are Norwegian champions.

I have been fortunate to have had a successful breeding and have had top winning Labrador in Norway 5 times. My greatest moment was winning BIS at the 100-year anniversary show at The Labrador Club in UK with Sh. Ch. Fieldvalley's Carmen Sofie in 2016. She is mother of 7 champions, hope more will come. Her son, Ch. Fieldvalley's Huckleberry Finn doing well. He was top winning Labrador in Norway 2019 and 2022.

I have judged Labradors since 2004, and I have judged in many countries in Europe, and I have had the honor to give CC in UK two times. I judge all retriever and spaniel breeds in the FCI system.

I am member of the Labrador Breed Council in Norway.

I am a pensioner and I have 4 children and 8 grandchildren. My other hobbies are 2. World War history, and I am a guide at the Gestapo head quarter museum in my city for schoolchildren. I also like to spend time to do some wood carving and making walking sticks.

I look forward to judging the 13th Labrador Retriever National Championship Show in Australia.

Mrs Jean Bryant (SA) – Sherepoint Retrievers

Property Classes

My first Labrador was when we lived in England – a lovely girl we called Cindy – she was a family pet and adored by our children.

Our next Labrador (in Australia now) was a black bitch. We named her Whitney after Whitney Houston; we bred one litter with her.

I showed Whitney to her show title, and competed in Retrieving Trials with her. She gained her Novice Retrieving Title, and also won placings in Restricted Trials.

In the past I have handled labradors for other people and thoroughly enjoyed doing so. In 2012 I judged the Labrador Club of Western Australia specialty Championship show – a great honour.

Whilst the breed I have now is Flatcoated Retrievers, even today at shows I make sure to watch the Labradors. I was fortunate to visit a renowned Labrador breeder overseas and see all their dogs and I think Labradors in Australia are equal to anywhere in the world.

I look forward to judge the property classes at the 13th Labrador National.

I first began entering Retrieving Trials in 1997 with my first dog, Jake, my 7yr old Goldy who Knew enough about Retrieving to be competitive in Restricted Stakes before he was retired.

I became a Judge of Novice Retrieving Stakes in the early 2000s and began judging All Age Trials in 2009.

I have Judged and competed in most Australian States at up to Championship level and trained and competed with four Goldy's, two of which achieved Retrieving Trial Champion Titles.

I am a past President of the Retrieving and Field trial Club of SA and have Chaired the Retrieving and Field Trials Advisory Panel for Dogs SA.

I look forward to Judging the Retrieving Ability Test for Gundogs at the Labrador Retriever Club of SA 2024 National and wish everyone the best of luck.

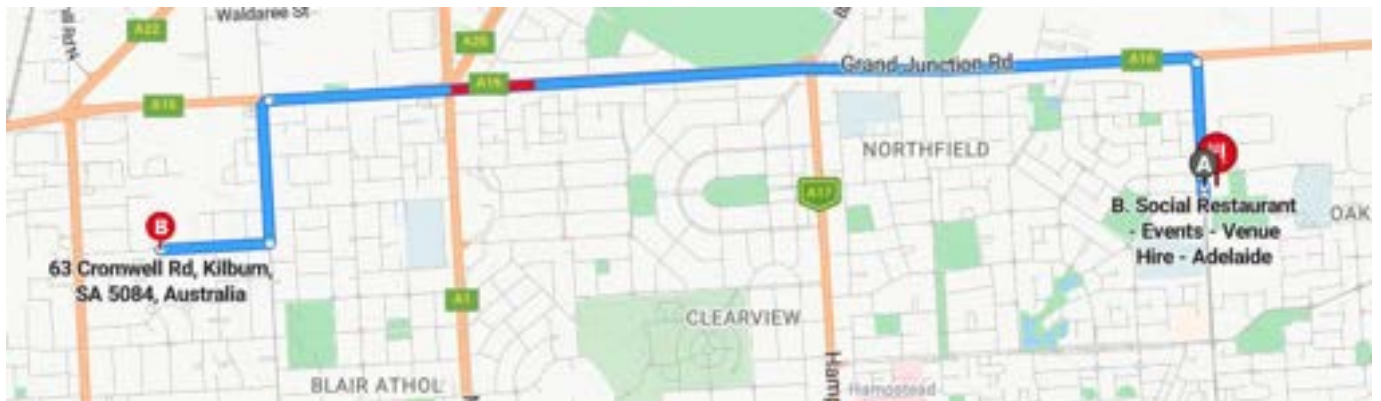
